Week 4 Day 1 Modern Day Challenges	Students will continue to come up with potential solutions, and will begin to come up with suggestions for their national	Continuing – start thinking of suggestions for the future of the park.	Reflection Journal: What is the one thing you can do to reduce your environmental impact?	Teacher check in opportunity in class. Helping facilitate student research and learning.
Week 4 Day 2 Modern Day Challenges	Continuing work on final summative task. Introduce individual letters to parks representative.	Continuing – research of modern day challenges and solutions – putting together final presentation – introduce letter	Reflection Journal: What is one recommendation you would make to your parks representative?	Check in with students related to their understandings about the final summative task.
Week 4 Day 3 Working on presentations	Putting together presentation (summative task)	Formative Feedback loop with other groups. Look at all group members recommendations from previous day.	Reflection Journal: From looking at the other groups project, what is one thing you would change about your own project?	Peer feedback cycles performed in class. Students start to critically assess and analyze their work.

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Week 4 Day 4 Working on presentations	Continuing work on final group task and individual letter.	Working on presentations	Reflection Journal: Redefine Discover, Protect and Connect	By repeating the same question form the first day of the unit, we can see how the students understanding has grown.
Week 5 Day 5 Presenting	In class presentations. Active listening questions.	Active listening questions that must be filled out in journal for each other park.	Reflection Journal: Fill out the active listening questions about other National Parks.	The students may require more time than allotted to put together their presentations, as such, the teacher may check-in and extend the unit if necessary.
